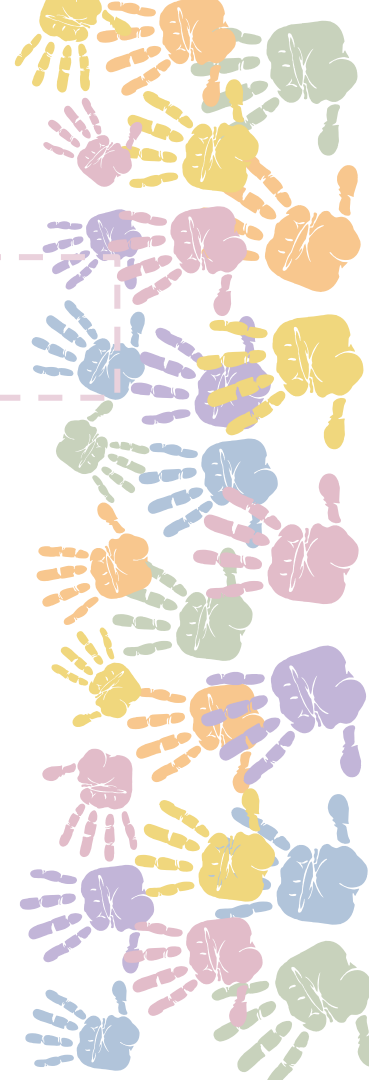

We will provide milk in school for your child.

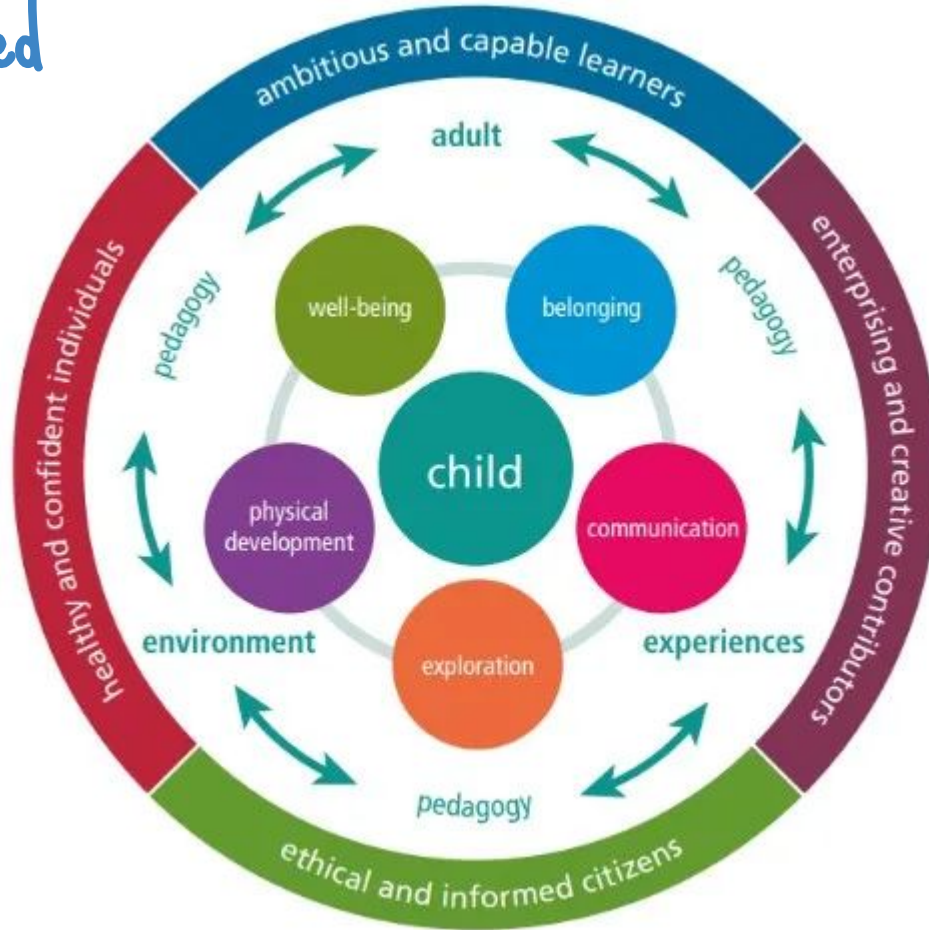


Our day

- We have a soft start to allow children to regulate and settle into the day.
- Our day incorporates lots of play.
- During the morning sessions we have a variety of fine and gross motor activities.
- Our lunch is at 11am. All Primary aged children are entitled to free school lunch.
- Before we start our afternoon sessions the children have milk.
- During the afternoons we complete a rotation of activities, which include play based learning, the 6 areas of learning as outlined in the Curriculum for Wales and the developmental pathways in the non maintained nursery curriculum.

- We use Seesaw to capture the children taking part in our activities, you will be able to access Seesaw and see what the children have been doing.
- During the first 4/5 weeks of the Autumn Term we will be completing a baseline assessment, which will help us to plan and provide the children with the tools they need to make progress through the year.
- You will be invited to a parents meetings in October and at the end of the Spring term.
- We will provide you with a written report in December and July.
